CASE MANAGEMENT ORDER

THIS MATTER came before the Court on the Trustee’s Motion for Case Management Order [Docket No. 133] (“Motion”). The Court held a hearing on the Motion on March 31, 2023. No further notice or opportunity for hearing is necessary. The relief to be granted in this Order is reasonable, appropriate, and in the best interests of the estate.

It is ORDERED that:

1 1. With respect to all matters which the Bankruptcy Code, the Federal Rules of Bankruptcy
2 Procedure (“Bankruptcy Rules”), or the Local Bankruptcy Rules authorize the Court to designate or limit
3 the parties entitled to notice, notice shall be deemed appropriate under the particular circumstances
4 presented if served only upon the following parties at the following addresses, unless notice of a new
5 address is given to the Court and the parties entitled to notice herein pursuant to this Order:

2 The entities and individuals listed above shall comprise the “Special Notice List.”

3 2. In addition to the Special Notice List, notice shall be sent to any party against
4 whom direct relief is sought by motion, application or otherwise, including by way of examples and not
5 limitation, the non-debtor party to an executory contract being assumed or rejected, and parties asserting
6 an interest in property being sold.

7 3. The Court reserves the right to modify the provisions of this Order on its own
8 motion or on the motion of any party-in-interest.

9 4. This Order shall not be construed to limit notices required to be sent to all creditors
10 under Bankruptcy Rules 2002(a)(1), 2002(a)(4), 2002(a)(6), and 2002(f).

11 5. Nothing in this Order shall be construed to prejudice the rights of any party-in-
12 interest to (i) move the Court to further limit or expand notice upon a showing of good cause including,
13 but not limited to, the right to file a motion seeking ex parte consideration, or consideration upon
14 shortened time; or (ii) seek an enlargement or reduction of a time period as provided in Bankruptcy Rules
15 9006(b) and (c).

16 6. Within seven days following the date of this Order, a copy of this Order shall be
17 sent to all parties listed on the official mailing matrix together with a notice referring parties to a website
18 containing instructions for opting for electronic notice only and opting to receive all notices in the case.

19 7. Notwithstanding any provision to the contrary herein, service via ECF upon
20 counsel of record for any of the parties identified herein pursuant to applicable rules or orders of this
21 Court shall constitute adequate notice for purposes of this Order.

22 8. The Trustee or her agent shall maintain the Special Notice List and make it
23 available upon request of any party-in-interest.
