**NOTICE OF CLAIMS PROCEDURE & CLAIMS BAR DATE**

Dear Investor,

**This correspondence will serve as your notice of the claims procedure and claims bar date in the J&J Receivership Action. Please review carefully and respond as indicated herein.**

As you may be aware, Geoff Winkler (the "Receiver"), was appointed by the Court as the permanent receiver for J&J Consulting Services, Inc., and its subsidiaries and affiliates (together, "J&J Consulting") in the above referenced J&J Receivership Action pending in the United States District Court for the District of Nevada (the "Court").

To facilitate an orderly claims process, the Receiver filed a Motion with the Court seeking an order: (1) setting a claims bar date; (2) approving a proposed claim form; and (3) approving summary claim procedures (ECF No. 821) ("Claims Motion"). On August 22, 2025, the Court entered its Order granting the Claims Motion (the "Claims Order") (ECF No. 845) a copy of which can be found at [jjconsulting-receivership.com](http://jjconsulting-receivership.com). **IMPORTANTLY, THE COURT HAS SET DECEMBER 1, 2025 AS THE CLAIMS BAR DATE IN THIS MATTER. ACCORDINGLY, IF YOU INTEND TO SUBMIT A CLAIM, IT MUST BE SUBMITTED BY 11:59 PM PDT ON DECEMBER 1, 2025.**

### **Filing a Claim**

If you believe you are entitled to a claim in the J&J Receivership Action, you may submit a Claim Form for the amount you believe you are entitled to and file a Claim Form with the Receiver by following the instructions at [cases.stretto.com/JJConsulting](http://cases.stretto.com/JJConsulting). Claims submitted electronically or mailed must be received by **11:59 PM PDT on December 1, 2025**. Claims that are received late will not receive a distribution from the Receiver or the receivership estate. **To be clear, if you do not return a completed Claim Form to the Receiver on or before the Claims Bar Date, you will not have a claim and will be forever barred.**
