

appearing that the relief requested is in the best interests of the Reorganized Debtors' estates; and the Court having jurisdiction to consider the Motion and the relief requested therein pursuant to 28 U.S.C. §§ 157 and 1334; and consideration of the Motion and the relief requested therein being a core proceeding pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 157(b); and venue being proper before this Court pursuant to 28 U.S.C. §§ 1408 and 1409; and notice of the Motion having been adequate and appropriate under the circumstances; and after due deliberation and sufficient cause appearing therefor, it is HEREBY ORDERED:

1. The Motion is granted as set forth herein.
2. The Open Cases are hereby closed effective as of the date of entry of this Final Decree.
3. Entry of this Final Decree is without prejudice to the rights of the Reorganized Debtors or any other party in interest to seek to reopen the Open Cases or the Affiliate Cases for good cause shown in accordance with section 350(b) of the Bankruptcy Code.
4. The Reorganized Debtors are authorized to take all actions necessary to effectuate the relief granted pursuant to this Final Decree in accordance with the Motion.
5. Subject to the performance of Stretto's obligations pursuant to this Final Decree, Stretto's engagement as the claims and noticing agent for the Open Cases and the Affiliate Cases is terminated effective as of the date of this Final Decree (the "Termination Date"), and Stretto is deemed discharged of its obligations in the Open Cases and the Affiliate Cases. Stretto will prepare a final claims register for the Clerk of the Court, pursuant to the current guidelines implementing under 28 U.S.C. § 156(c). Stretto will box and transport all claims to the Federal Archives, at the direction of the Clerk of the Court. Stretto Agent will keep electronic copies of all records until one year after the Termination Date (after which time Stretto may, but is not

required to, destroy such records, unless otherwise required by applicable law) and that Stretto need not keep paper copies of such records. Stretto will transfer electronic copies of the final claims register, all claims and claim related documents and filings to the Clerk of the Court. The services rendered by Stretto pursuant to this paragraph shall be charged to the bankruptcy estate.

6. For the purposes of calculating quarterly fees payable to the Office of the United States Trustee for the Eastern District of Virginia in accordance with 28 U.S.C. § 1930(a)(6), all disbursements made by the Reorganized Debtors up to the date of entry of this Final Decree will be included in the calculation, and the Reorganized Debtors shall promptly pay these amounts upon entry of this order and in any event, no later than 14 days after entry.

7. Nothing contained in this Final Decree shall alter, amend or otherwise have any impact on any pending or subsequently filed adversary proceeding.

8. The terms and conditions of this Final Decree shall be immediately effective and enforceable upon its entry.

9. This Court retains exclusive jurisdiction with respect to all matters arising from or related to the implementation, interpretation, and enforcement of this Final Decree.
