



Positioning Amyris for Long-Term Success

Dear Valued Partner,

Given our relationship, we wanted to update you on actions we have taken to position Amyris for the future. In coordination with our Board of Directors and advisors, we have been actively reviewing strategic alternatives as they relate to our go-forward business model. Our principal goal has been to continue to focus on our core Lab-to-Market™ capabilities while reducing our costs, improving operational effectiveness, and achieving sustainable profitable growth.

Based on this work, we determined that an in-court restructuring of our finances and operations is the best path to achieve a comprehensive solution to improve our cost structure, capital structure, and liquidity position while streamlining our portfolio and creating a more sustainable go-forward business rooted in Amyris' ground-breaking science, formulation capabilities, and technology.

To facilitate this restructuring, Amyris and certain of our domestic subsidiaries commenced voluntary Chapter 11 proceedings in the U.S. Bankruptcy Court for the District of Delaware on August 9, 2023. Our entities outside the U.S. are not included in the proceedings.

In tandem, to advance our restructuring goals and maximize the value of our assets, we are planning to exit the brands in our consumer portfolio and will begin marketing them for sale.

A few important things for you to know:

- **Throughout this process, we will operate our business as usual, and our vendor relationships will remain essential.**
- **We will pay our vendors for all authorized goods received and services rendered after the filing date.**
- **We have secured a commitment for \$190 million of debtor-in-possession financing to support our continued operations. This financing will be sufficient to fund our day-to-day operations and meet our go-forward obligations to you.**
- As you may be aware, under bankruptcy law, companies are generally prohibited from making any payments to vendors for goods received or services rendered before a filing. Those seeking payment from Amyris on account of any potential “prepetition” claims will need to do so through the Chapter 11 claims process, which will be managed by our claims agent, Stretto.
