**ORDER GRANTING CHAPTER 7 TRUSTEE’S SECOND MOTION
TO EXTEND CLAIMS BAR DATE TO FILE INTERCOMPANY CLAIMS**

THIS CAUSE came before the Court upon the *Second Motion to Extend Claims Bar Date to File Intercompany Claims* [ECF No. 992] (the “Motion”) filed by Marie E. Henkel, as the Chapter 7 trustee of the bankruptcy estates of Starboard Group of Spacecoast, Starboard Group of

Southeast Florida, LLC, Starboard Group of Tampa, LLC, Starboard Group of Tampa II, LLC, Starboard Group of Alabama, LLC, 7 S & M Foods, LLC, 9 S & M Foods, LLC, and 10 S & M Foods, LLC, and the Court, having reviewed the Motion, having noted that no objection to the Motion has been filed, having determined that no hearing on the Motion is necessary, and based on the record, it is

ORDERED as follows:

1. The Motion is **GRANTED**.
2. The time within which any party may file intercompany proofs of claims as between the various Debtors¹ is extended through and including May 30, 2025, without prejudice to further requests for extension. For the sake of clarity, this Order does not otherwise extend any other claims bar dates.
3. The Debtors shall continue to maintain records related to the intercompany claims to the extent such records exist and are kept in the ordinary course.
