Dear Claimant:

We are in receipt of your claim submitted in the Traders Domain receivership, and it has been assigned the above-referenced claim number. In all future communications regarding your claim, please refer to your claim number.

Please find enclosed the *Receiver's Amended Claims Report*, which includes my recommendation regarding your claim. Please note your claim number above and review **Exhibit F** to the [Receiver's Amended Claims Report](#) to see my recommendation regarding your claim. There is a Reconciliation Code assigned to your claim that explains the reason for any reduction or denial of the claim you filed. The key for the Reconciliation Codes is on page 45 of Exhibit F. If your claim was allowed in the full amount, you do not need to take any further action. **You are advised that the Receiver's recommendation regarding your claim reflects only your recognized loss, not the amount that will be distributed to you from the Traders Domain receivership.**

If you disagree with my recommendation regarding your claim, you may object. The deadline to object to my recommendation is **MARCH 5, 2026**. Any objection must be made in writing and emailed to tradersdomainobjections@stretto.com or uploaded to the claims objection portal at - <https://cases.stretto.com/tradersdomainclaim/>: (1) specifying your intent to object to my recommendation regarding your claim, (2) explaining the basis for your disagreement with my recommendation, and (3) if necessary, providing additional documentation that may support your claim (which you have not already submitted).

Please DO NOT file your objection or supporting documents with the Court.

The Receiver will seek to resolve as many objections as possible, which may result in the revision of the Receiver's recommendation regarding your claim. By April 24, 2026, the Receiver

will file with the Court a copy of all timely, unresolved objections, together with the Receiver's response to those objections, and shall serve a copy of the same on all claimants that submitted an unresolved objection. If the Court's determination of your objection results in a revision of the Receiver's recommendation on your claim, the Receiver will inform you of the revised allowed claim amount by emailing you a Revised Claims Report. The Court shall have sole jurisdiction and serve as the exclusive venue to consider your objection. The Court's determination on a claimant's objection is final and may not be appealed to any other Court.

After the Court has made its final determination regarding all claimants' claims, the Receiver will file his Motion to Approve the Monetary Distribution Plan and, upon the Court's approval of that Motion, the Receiver will make his Initial Distribution from the funds the Receiver has marshalled and reserved for distribution to claimants with Court-approved allowed claims. The amounts and method by which the Initial Distributions will be made will be subject to Court approval. The date and amount of such distribution are not known at this time.
